## Prep the RG6 with the 45-520

## Tool directions

- With a properly adjusted 45-526 cable prep tool, squeeze handles and open the jaw.
- Insert the coax into the tool in the direction of the coax icon on the tool. Coax should be flush with the end wall of the tool.
- Rotate tool clockwise 5-8 times around cable. You will hear the blades cutting through the different coax layers. When the cutting sound fades, stop rotating the tool.
- Squeeze handles, open tool.
- Pull cable from tool.
- Remove slugs if necessary.



- Adjustable depth and fixed width blades.
- Slider adjusts for 6/59/58(plenum) coax.
- Replaceable blades accepts other cartridges
- Provides standard 1/4" × 1/4" × 1/4" prep.



While spinning tool, hold coax near the tool side to prevent the tool from "walking" or wobbling, which leads to an uneven or spiraling cut.
